The Regional Staff Interpreter (RSI) would be part of our core staff interpreter team. The RSI would be interpreting in a wide variety of arenas, within healthcare, business, conference, government, community settings and more. Assignments will mostly be on-site but will also include some remote video work. The RSI will have the opportunity to work independently as well as team with our amazing hearing and Deaf interpreters.

Partners Interpreting has staff interpreters, who are typically scheduled weeks in advance. However, we have a high volume of short-notice requests - these are the assignments that the RSI would be given. This will result in a very dynamic schedule that changes from week to week, even day to day. Additionally, the RSI would cover for other staff and/or non-staff interpreters who may call out sick.

Candidates must possess the ability to work as part of a team, flexibility, a strong range for interpreting in a wide array of settings. Keys to success include soft people and communication skills, patience and a positive 'get it done' attitude. This position requires the ability to travel outside primary regions assigned to other staff.
