An interpreter is one person. Access is a whole system.

Most districts think the decision is between a Partners Interpreting interpreter and a less-expensive independent one. The real decision is between a single person and a complete communication-access system. Here is the difference, side by side.

Continuity across the year	Depends on one person staying	A dedicated team that learns your student
